

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

'AOGP Exam Preparation' PRIZE DRAW

AOGP is giving away \$1,000 credit to be used towards any AOGP exam preparation workshop or webinar to the winning eligible entrant, plus free attendance at a ProMBS workshop, subject to the following terms and conditions. By entering into the prize draw, the entrant agrees to these terms and conditions.

Who can enter?

To be eligible, the entrant must be a doctor who is preparing to sit the AMC Clinical Exam, ACRRM or RACGP Fellowship exams, and who has completed the competition entry form between 5 March 2020 and 6 April 2020.

How to enter

AOGP will automatically enter the entrant upon receiving their completed form. Only one entry is permitted per entrant, however an extra entry can be submitted per friend referred via the entry form.

The Prize

There will be one winner, chosen at random from the total pool of eligible entrants. The prize may not be redeemed for its cash value but is transferrable to, or can be shared with, another person. The winner can choose to use the \$1,000 to participate in one or more of AOGP exam preparation workshop/s or webinar/s. The \$1,000 is a credit only toward workshop/s or webinar/s and cannot be used for other purposes, such as, but not limited to, accommodation or transport to workshop/s or webinar/s. The winner will also be provided a free ticket to a ProMBS Workshop, as scheduled by AOGP and listed on the ProMBS website (www.prombs.com.au). The ProMBS Workshop ticket does not include associated attendance costs, such as (but not limited to) transport and accommodation costs. The ProMBS ticket is not redeemable for its cash value, but can be transferred to another person.

Promotional emails/privacy

By entering the prize draw, the entrant agrees to receive emails from AOGP until such time as the entrant wishes to unsubscribe and be removed from the AOGP email list. The entrant also agrees that the information provided to AOGP at the time of entry into the prize draw may be retained by AOGP and used by AOGP in connection with its promotional activities.

The Prize Draw

The prize draw will be conducted by way of random selection in such manner as AOGP may in its absolute discretion determine at 10am on 7 April 2020. The draw will be held at AOGP's office at Lower Level 183 Melbourne Street North Adelaide, South Australia.

AOGP will first draw an entry for verification (Initial Winner) and then draw sufficient entries to form the reserve list. All entries will be recorded in the order drawn. Upon verification, if the Initial Winner is invalid or ineligible, or does not contact AOGP to claim the prize within 2 weeks of being notified as the winner, the first valid reserve entrant will be assigned as the winner. The winner will be notified by email on 7 April 2020.

AOGP's decision in relation to any aspect of the prize draw is final.

No Liability

Notwithstanding the above terms and conditions, AOGP may at its discretion modify, suspend or terminate the prize draw, in which case AOGP shall have no further liability to any entrant.
